### **LNG refuelling on the A4, A67 and A17**

DCB Energy and PitPoint.LNG are joining forces to realize three new LNG refuelling locations

Recently Carola and Freddy Berkel and Jan Willem Drijver, on behalf of DCB Energy and PitPoint.LNG respectively, signed a contract for the realization of three LNG refuelling locations. The construction of these new installations at DCB Energy sites is the next step in PitPoint.LNG's strategy to develop a European LNG refuelling infrastructure. The first LNG refuelling location to come on stream will be Truck Easy Harnaspolder<sup>1</sup>, scheduled to be operational from the end of this year. Truck Easy Venlo<sup>2</sup> will follow shortly thereafter. Truck Easy Roosendaal<sup>3</sup> will be ready from the start of 2018.

### **Cleaner fuel for road transport**

LNG stands for Liquefied Natural Gas. LNG has been used as a fuel in the Netherlands for a number of years now and its popularity in heavy goods transport is gaining year on year. LNG burns cleaner than Euro VI standard diesel: 30 percent less harmful emissions (PM10 and NOx) and 10% less CO2 emissions. In addition to LNG, the locations will also offer CNG (Compressed Natural Gas). Jan Willem Drijver, managing director of PitPoint.LNG: "Running on LNG is less harmful for local air quality and therefore for the health of residents in the vicinity."

### **Easy access**

The new LNG refuelling locations mean cleaner transport on LNG is now even more within reach. The locations are next to busy roads that are popular routes for truck transport. According to Drijver: "Take the Harnaspolder site in Den Hoorn that is centrally located relative to Royal Flora Holland, Delft, The Hague, Rotterdam and Westland, and is easy to access from the A4, A12, A13, N211 exit 12 and The Hague South. Trucks pull in on their way to and from the flower auction and, en route to their destination, they pass literally a couple of metres from our LNG refuelling location. This makes opting for a cleaner fuel like LNG an easy choice for carriers transporting flowers."
